SPACESHIP EARTH

Since people first traveled in space, the earth has been compared to a spaceship. In a spaceship, astronauts live in a selfcontained system that must meet all their needs. A breakdown in the system providing fresh air could be deadly in a matter of minutes. A loss of food would require a dash back



to earth. If something goes catastrophically wrong on the earth, however, there is no place to dash for help.

The natural systems on earth are remarkably forgiving. Though we pollute our water, the water cycle lifts evaporated water to the clouds and returns it as clean rain. Microorganisms are able to convert some water pollutants into harmless by-products.

When we pollute the air, the earth and its natural systems dilute the problem and begin the process of cleaning it up for us to breathe again.

Perhaps it seems there's so much clean air and water that we needn't worry about resources. But this isn't so! The rain that falls in the Midwest has more acid in it than normal, and people have created toxic compounds. No one knows how many harmful chemicals can be produced before the cycles or purification are not able to function.

Only if attitudes of care and conservation prevail on Spaceship Earth will its inhabitants be able to cruise the solar system indefinitely.
