MARK YOUR CALENDAR! BOAT REMOVAL DEADLINE – NOVEMBER 30

Thankfully, we still have beautiful boating weather ahead this fall. However, here is a date to mark on your calendar: All boats must be removed from all marinas, beaches and common areas by Wednesday, November 30. Need help with removal? Innsbrook will move your boats for you for \$35 per small boat, plus \$20 each additional boat, and \$100 per pontoon boat. Do you want Innsbrook to store your boat for you? We can do that, too! The cost is \$100 for pontoons and \$50 for small boats. *Boats not removed by Thursday, December 1 will be removed by Innsbrook with double the fee to the owner.* Ext. 9163.

nature note

OH, CANADA (GEESE!)

In the bird world, if you sport a collar and bracelet, chances are you're a Canada goose. To learn about Canada goose population changes and movements, biologists tag the birds with legbands and neck collars. Birds with black collars and white numbers were banded in Minnesota. Birds with blue collars and white numbers were banded during migration stopovers in the Midwest. And birds with orange collars and white numbers were banded on the nesting grounds in Manitoba and Ontario, Canada. During their migration in spring and fall, you may see a flock of geese with collars of several different colors!
