## Nature Note

### Wild Ginger

Take a walk on one of Innsbrook's nature trails – or on your own piece of the Innsbrook woods – and you'll probably spot this easily recognizable spring wildflower. Wild ginger (*Asarum canadense*) is an easy grower, mostly in medium to wet, well-drained soil, in part and full shade. It spreads slowly and forms an attractive ground cover.

This Missouri native spring wildflower blooms from April to May. Its cup-shaped purple-brown flowers are about an inch wide and appear on short, ground-level stems arising at the base of the plant. They are usually hidden from view, so a little investigation is necessary. The flowers are quite attractive on close inspection.

This stemless plant features two downy, heart-shaped, handsomely veined, dark green basal leaves. The leaves

## Recycling Tips

**Items to Recycle:** Office paper, newspaper, envelopes, folders, spiral notebooks, paper back books, magazines, catalogs, telephone books, cardboard (not waxed), paper bags, milk and juice jugs, food containers, narrow neck containers (#3 plastic resin such as household cleaners), aluminum cans, trays, and foil, steel cans, soda and water bottles. **\*All containers must be emptied.**

**Non-Recyclable Items:** Styrofoam, food contaminated materials (greasy pizza boxes), motor oil, insecticide, herbicide or hazardous chemical containers, expanded foam containers, restroom papers, and papers that contains synthetic materials. can be up to 6 inches wide. This plant is not related to culinary ginger (*Zingiber officinale*), but the roots of this plant produce a scent that is reminiscent of it.

Fresh or dried roots were used by early Americans as a ginger substitute, but the plant is not normally used today for culinary purposes.
