Welcome to Innsbrook, kick your shoes off and stay a while.



UTV Registration and Restrictions

In response to concerns regarding noise disturbances caused by gas and diesel-powered UTVs, the Innsbrook Owners Association Trustees have recently made an amendment to the Declaration of Trust and Restrictions regarding the registration and operation of such vehicles within the community.

Effective April 1, 2024, no previously unregistered gas or diesel-powered UTVs will be permitted to register within the development. Gas or diesel-powered UTVs that were registered prior to April 1, 2024 will be allowed onsite until January 1, 2029, after which they will no longer be permitted to operate on Innsbrook roads. Violators of this rule will be subject to fines for operating or maintaining UTVs on the premises. This amendment aims to enhance the peace and tranquility of our community for all residents and guests.

COURSE SCORES A HOLE-IN-ONE WITH MORE UPDATES & ADDITIONS

Another banner year is ahead for Innsbrook's golf course and Pro Shop team! Always improving, the course has undergone some updates and upgrades in the last year, welcomed the delivery of new GPS-enabled golf carts, and of course, the return of our favorite food truck, the Par Bar.

Upgrades Along the Course

Last summer, new technology hit the course in the form of four-wheels. Players are now able to ride through their nine or 18-holes of play in a new fleet of Club Car golf carts featuring a GPS system. The new carts bring wonderful improvements to the playing experience at Innsbrook. There is no more searching for yardage markers or making sure your laser range finder catches the flag to determine your distance – that information and more is right in front of you as you pull up to your golf ball.

These new carts also help our staff better manage the golf course and improve maintenance practices. These systems allow golf course management to track all golf carts, monitor the pace of play, restrict parts of the course where carts are prohibited, and send messages to specific golf carts and players from inside the pro shop.

This high level of technology delivers helpful and real-time location information for players to manage their pace of play and plan their next shot, as well as a cost-effective and efficient communication system for golf course management to instantly communicate with players.

We want to make sure everyone is enjoying the full benefits the carts allow. Private golf carts are not allowed on the golf course, with the exception of those registered by annual pass holders.

Par Bar and Patio

Rollin' into its seasonal parking space at the turn and end of the 18th hole, the Par Bar provides a literal meal on wheels for property owners, players, and guests alike. The Par Bar's attractive form and convenient location offers an additional eatery in the Innsbrook community for those to swing by for a quick bite on the way to the next tee box, or a place to dine alfresco with family on the new pro shop patio. This year, the Par Bar is back and better than ever with delicious new menu items, a line-up of summer events, and an eager staff of Innsbrook all-stars ready to please palates with their easy-to-eat and on-the-go favorites.

Additionally, please refrain from wearing items such as t-shirts, blue jeans, denim, gym shorts, tank tops, and other attire deemed inappropriate.

Off-Season Course Maintenance

During the off-season, our dedicated team embarked on a comprehensive maintenance and update endeavor to enhance the golf course experience at Innsbrook. Acquiring new maintenance equipment in late summer and fall was just the beginning of our efforts. Throughout the winter months, our team diligently cleared brush and small trees along key areas of the course, including hole #2, behind #7 and #8, and between #14 and #16. The transformative results of this labor will be readily apparent, as improved air flow around each green promises better conditions and smoother putting surfaces.

These improvements and additions offer benefits far beyond a round of golf. Property owners and guests can look forward to an ever-improving and beautiful environment on and around the course, as well as new amenities to enhance the Innsbrook golf experience.

RESTORING HISTORY AND CULTURE AT INNSBROOK ONE STRUCTURE AT A TIME

Innsbrook's years of growth and tradition were built on deep rooted, historical land that has now become an interest to residents and a unique part of the Innsbrook culture.

What started as a very small part of the huge land acquisition by the United States government from France in 1803, the Louisiana Purchase, has now become a historic site on the Innsbrook property. In 1997, Innsbrook Corporation purchased 400 acres, including the building known as the "Log Cabin" and surrounding land, knowing very little about the home and the historical stories hidden within its aging, wooded walls. In 2009, the Log Cabin, surrounding structures, and nearly 1.5 acres encircling them was deeded to the Innsbrook Historical Society and now make up what is called the Historic Village, located below Alpine Dam.

The 1840s log cabin is the staple structure of the historic village. In 2010, the dilapidated 1840s log cabin was stripped down to the bare log walls, and all old chinking was removed prior to restoration. After building a front porch, replacing wall logs, installing electric, and much more, the restoration project was completed in 2015. Today, the Log Cabin is host to community events such as live music, artist workshops, lectures, and many other activities.

Originally built near what is now the Innsbrook West gate in 1881, the Upper Charrette Schoolhouse was in use as a one-room school, providing education for area children for nearly 30 years. After being rebuilt in 1909, the schoolhouse closed in 1941, leaving it vacant with only minor maintenance completed on the structure. In 2019, IHS volunteers deconstructed the schoolhouse, moved "pieces" to the Historical Village, and reconstructed it into like-new condition. Inside, visitors will find a fully furnished schoolhouse, just as a typical one-room school of the 1900s would look like. Just last year, a wishing well was added to the front of the schoolhouse.

In 2022, IHS volunteers added a fully modernized restroom facility on site. The modern restroom facility was designed to look like a historic shed, and is now available for use for residents and guests during their visit to the historic village.

Celebrating over a decade of restoring culture and history at Innsbrook, the IHS is striving to make the Historical Village a destination of choice for residents and visitors. In March 2023, the Innsbrook Historical Society embarked on a monumental project—the reconstruction of a 19th-century historic barn generously donated by Innsbrook neighbors Mike and Diane Vaughn.

Dating back to around 1875, the barn stands as a relic of an era dating back to post Civil War. In those times, the barn served as a vital hub for farm operations, providing shelter for mules—the "tractors" of the era—during inclement weather and storing essential supplies like hay in its loft, capable of holding up to 1,000 bales when filled to capacity.

Following the barn's donation, dedicated volunteers from the Innsbrook Historical Society undertook the complex task of disassembling the structure and relocating the lumber to its new home at the Historic Village site for reconstruction. Over the span of nine months and amidst thorough site preparation, the process of reassembling the barn commenced. While the original barn measured 26'x40', the new structure will boast expansions on both sides, resulting in a final size of 40'x40'. Once completed, the barn will serve as a gathering and meeting space for IHS members and the Innsbrook community.

- The new Tyrol pool is a swim-at-your-own-risk pool, with no lifeguard present. There are no age restrictions. The pool will be open from sunrise to sunset. Security will unlock the gates in the morning and lock them in the evening. Please vacate at lockup.

Pool Reminders:

- Soft-sided coolers and snacks are allowed at the Commons pool on Mondays and Tuesdays when the Summerhaus is closed. Per our liquor license, all food and beverages purchased at the Summerhaus must be consumed in the concession area, with the exception of water. No glass containers at any pools, please.
- At all pools, children under the age of 12 must be accompanied at all times by a responsible person age 16 or older. Children who are not potty-trained must wear a swim diaper, which are available for purchase from the pool attendant. Accidents result in having to shut down and clean the pool, closing it for a significant amount of time.
- Pool noodles and baby floats are permitted in the pool and lazy river, but inner tubes and/or rafts are not as they can be disruptive to fellow swimmers.
- The Innsbrook Owners Association has the right to close the facility due to the weather for everyone's safety. Facility closings are at the discretion of the office manager, lifeguard assistant or the facility's general manager.

During Summer Breeze concerts, Summerhaus concessions will be available through the window outside of the pool fence. Innsbrook Owner Association concessions will be located at the entrance to concert area near the parking lot. Concessions include glow-in-the-dark items, candy, sno-cones and more.

DON'T BE "TRASHY" - REMINDERS FOR RECYCLING AND WASTE MANAGEMENT

At Innsbrook, we take pride in fostering a clean and sustainable environment for our community. Proper disposal of trash and recycling items is essential to maintain the beauty and functionality of our surroundings. To ensure everyone's cooperation, we've outlined guidelines and resources for your convenience.

We have conveniently located trash and recycling depots throughout the community:

- Just south of the Main Gate on Aspen Way Dr.
- Just north of the Farmhouse off Innsbrook Dr.
- At the Konstanz Gate Entrance off South Konstanz Dr.
- At the Linden Gate Entrance off Linden Crossing

Please refrain from using the bins at the Clubhouse Bar & Grille, Charrette Creek Commons, The Market Café and Creamery, or Aspen Center, as they are designated for commercial use only.

For household trash, we provide a compactor located at the trash depot south of the Main Gate on Aspen Way Dr. To use the compactor, simply open the side door, deposit your trash, and close the door. Never open the door when the green light is flashing and the siren is sounding, as it indicates that the compactor is in operation. For safety reasons, never enter the compactor area.

To maintain cleanliness and safety, please refrain from disposing of the following items in our dumpsters:

- Iron or steel
- Car parts or tires
- Construction debris (e.g., lumber, drywall, fixtures)
- Appliances or bulky items such as furniture and mattresses
- Oil, paint, or chemicals requiring special disposal
- Car batteries

We also offer recycling dumpsters at all of our trash depots. Accepted recyclables include:

- All cans (aluminum/steel/tin)
- Paper milk and juice cartons
- Green, clear, and brown glass bottles
- All paper tears (newspapers, magazines, junk mail, office paper)
- Cardboard and paper boxes
- Plastic containers

Recyclable items should be loose and not placed in plastic trash bags. No plastic grocery bags, window glass, dinnerware, ceramics or #6 plastics (styrofoam). Remove paperclips/staples from paper. All cans, bottles and cardboard (such as pizza boxes) should be free of debris. Recyclables can be co-mingled; there's no need to separate items.

To uphold cleanliness and efficiency, we have enhanced surveillance at our trash sites. Improper use of dumpsters or compactors will result in a \$250 fine. If you're unsure about whether an item belongs in our dumpsters, please contact property management for clarification by emailing harry.harisberger@innsbrook-resort.com, or by calling 636.928.3366 x9193.

Big Trash Weekends

Each April and October, dumpsters are available for disposal of your bulky, unwanted items and trash, including furniture, during our scheduled Big Trash Weekends. For two days only, owners may bring their bulky trash (old furniture, mattresses, etc.) to the Property Management Building. No construction or auto waste will be accepted (no toilets, bathtubs, broken tiles, auto parts, tires, etc.). Only items from your Innsbrook property are allowed, absolutely no outside waste, please. 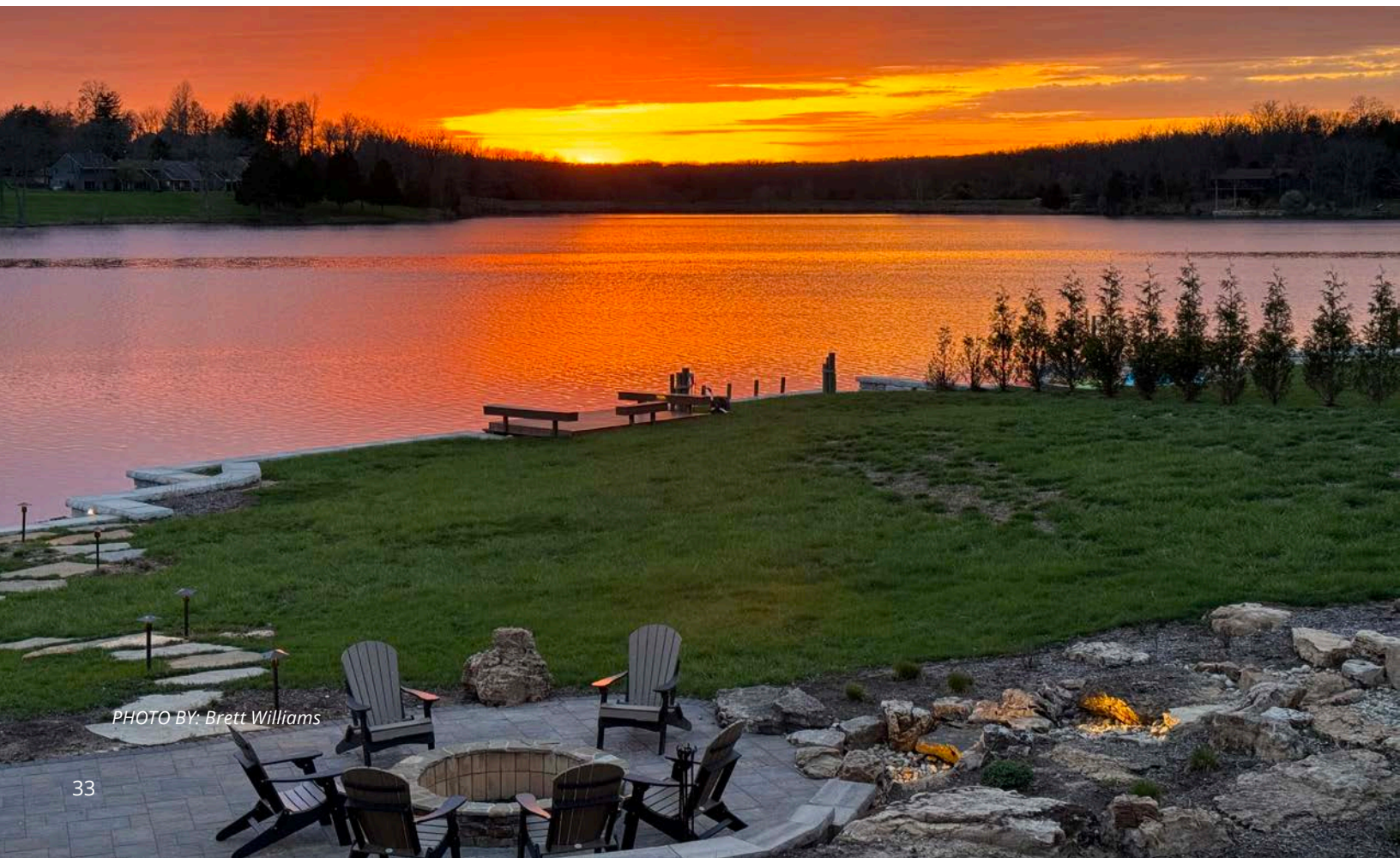

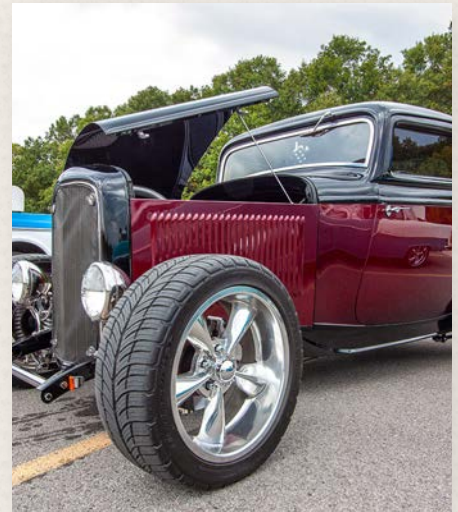

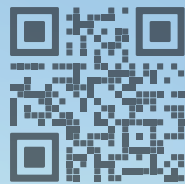
