

Bluebird Trail Report:

This week, our hard working bluebird parents have 96 nests containing 97 eggs and 280 chicks. 53 chicks have already fledged and are flying around Innsbrook.

In real estate, they always say location, location, location, that's the important thing. This week, we learned location is really important to the bluebirds, too. We put up a nest box in a small clearing along Alpine Lake Drive three years ago. Immediately, the birds nested in it, but the last two years there has been no activity. So, two weeks ago, we moved the box across the street and down about 30 feet where there was a larger open area. The next morning, we saw a bluebird sitting on top of the house. The next day, we checked the box and there was some dried grass inside. Two days later it had a full nest and yesterday there were five beautiful bluebird eggs inside- location, location, location!

IBK Fishing Club Tips:

You may be seeing schools of bluegill near your shoreline. We hope so! The Fishing Club has been trying to build up populations through stocking and feeding programs. Bluegill spawn in the early summer, hopefully making many more bluegill. Their presence on the lake edges often attracts the bigger fish back into the shallows. To mimic the natural pattern, run baits from the shoreline out into greater depths, as if a bluegill is fleeing its spawning spot to the main lake. The big fish are often lurking near the first depth change.

NATURE NOTES

Copperhead vs Northern Watersnake: What are the differences?

Living in harmony with nature is what attracts so many to the Innsbrook community. The surrounding forests and lakes not only provide incredible views and recreation opportunities for residents but also offer the perfect home for some slithering, unwanted guests - snakes.

Getting to know the difference between non-venomous and venomous snakes and how to identify them can help to avoid direct encounters and ease your fears. The most commonly mistaken identity in our area is the non-venomous northern watersnake vs the venomous copperhead. Learn how to identify each below:

- Patterns: Copperheads have an hourglass-shaped pattern, whereas the northern water snake has a bulb-shaped pattern.
- Coloring: Copperheads have a pale brown to pinkish-brown background skin, while northern watersnakes have a gray, brown, reddish-black, or brownish-black background skin
- Head Shape: Both snakes have triangular heads, but copperheads' are colored orange or copper, while nothern watersnakes' are colored according to their skin color
- Cross-bands: The darker, rusty brown cross-bands on the watersnake are widest on the back. That is the opposite of the copperhead, which has dark bands that are skinniest on the back or even fail to connect
- Habitat: Copperheads can swim, but are mainly found in woodlands, while the watersnake can mostly be found in and around water.
