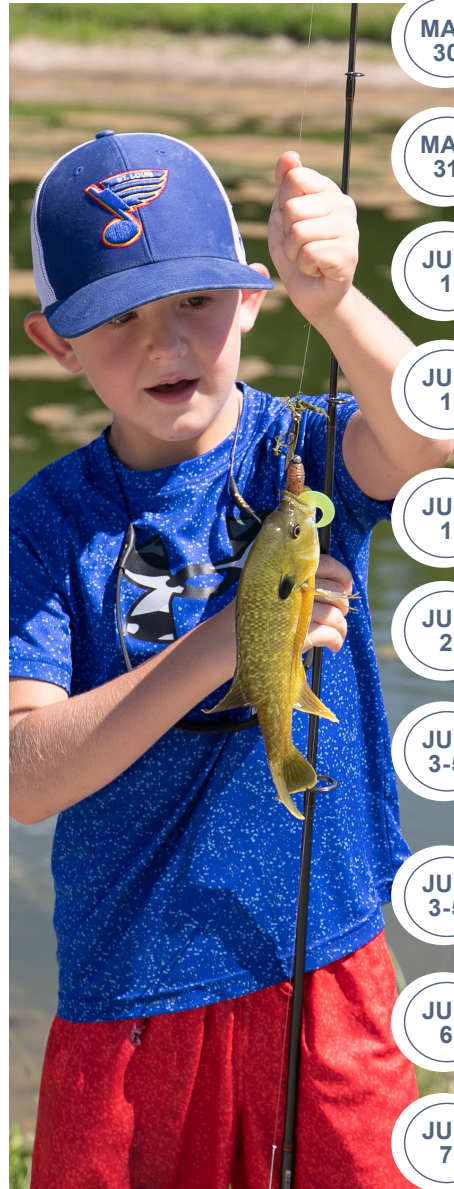

Bluebird Trail Report

This week our Innsbrook bluebirds are very busy, many already having their second nest. There are 91 active nests containing 268 eggs, and 89 chicks. Thirty-five more chicks have fledged. They have already fledged 371 chicks this season! They are facing stiff competition right now from our tree swallows. The swallows have taken over a number of their nest boxes in the last couple of weeks. They rarely attack an established bluebird nest but will steal the box if it is empty. They are native species and very beneficial birds because they eat only insects. Their nests are also made of grasses but usually have a flatter cup shape and are lined with many white feathers. The eggs are white and pointy on one end. If your nest box is used by swallows, just enjoy watching them, they are great parents and beautiful fliers.
