Bluebird Trail Report

We now have 88 active bluebird nests containing 134 eggs and 241 hungry chicks. Thirty-five more chicks have fledged.

Have you had trouble with paper wasps or yellow jackets in your nest box? They will build their gray papery nests on the ceiling of the box. Bluebirds will rarely use the box if it is occupied by wasps. The best method to get rid of them is to spray the wasps through the entrance hole at night with 0.1 percent pyrethrin spray. Then plug the hole until morning. The next day clean out the box, removing the nests and the dead adults and then rubbing the ceiling of the box with a bar of lvory soap. This will deter the wasps from attaching their nests there.

Flag Day is Our Everyday Blessing Reminder

The American Flag is made up of 13 horizontal stripes -- seven red alternating with six white representing the original 13 Colonies. Red symbolizes hardiness and valor, white symbolizes purity and innocence, and blue represents vigilance, perseverance, and justice. The stars represent the 50 states of the Union. Betsy Ross, a Philadelphia seamstress, was commissioned to sew the first flag of the United States. The American Flag has many nicknames – The Stars and Stripes, The Red, White, and Blue, Star Spangled Banner, and Old Glory.

During the War of 1812 between Britain and America, Francis Scott Key, was held captive on a British prison ship in Baltimore Harbor during their attack on Fort McHenry. Upon seeing the survival of The Stars and Stripes after such a horrific bombardment, Key wrote our Star-Spangled Banner poem and set it to a popular British drinking tune – To Anacreon in Heaven. In AD 1824, ship captain William Driver was given a 10x17ft American flag by his mother to take on his travels around the world. He respectfully called it "Old Glory" as a symbol of freedom and as a reminder of home. Old Glory has been to the North pole, Mount Everest, and the moon. The flag is folded 13 times into a triangle to resemble the tri-cornered hat worn by George Washington and his Continental Army Soldiers during the Revolutionary War. Each fold of the flag has meaning as it honors life, veterans, mothers, fathers, and God.

When the flag is completely folded, the stars are uppermost, reminding us of our national motto, "In God We Trust." President Harry S. Truman from Independence Missouri made June 14 Flag day -- the day in 1777 the Continental Congress adopted it as our nation's flag. Go ahead and proudly fly our American flag on that day and everyday as a celebration of the many blessings in your life.
