Bluebird Trail Report

This week our hard working bluebirds have 73 nests containing 72 eggs and 218 chicks. Seventy-five more chicks have fledged. Our birds have already fledged 493 chicks this season!

It's fun to watch bluebirds fly, they use flight in three ways while feeding. They "hawk" insects by flying out from a perch to catch them midair. They also have the ability to "hover" as they search for food on the ground, hanging in the air like a small helicopter. And they do normal feeding by short flights from a perch to the ground and back within a few seconds. This is called "drop feeding." Keep your eyes on your bluebirds and see which method of feeding they're using.

The Fireworks Extravaganza takes place over Lake Aspen beginning after dark around 9:15 p.m. The best viewing areas for the show are: Around the condos; Lionshead or Geneva Beach; on the Lake Aspen dam leading to the condos; on the Aspen Center patio (reservations required); Aspen Center Lake Stage (reservations required); or on the hillside behind the Aspen Center (reservations required).

For guests and owners viewing the show from the Aspen Center, a ticketed event visit <u>https://bit.ly/3UTUMXY</u> for tickets:

- Parking at Aspen (hillside, Aspen Patio, Lake Stage) is included with prepurchased ticket.
- 5:30 PM: Parking Opens
- 5:30 PM: Viewing opens on Lake Stage, Aspen Patio, and Aspen hillside (viewing package not included with dining)
- 5:30-8:30 PM: Live Entertainment by Pink House USA

NATURE NOTES Woodpeckers: Master Builders

Woodpeckers are powerful birds that climb tree trunks and use their beaks like jackhammers. These master builders chisel out nests in tree cavities. As such, their eggs are white as there is no need for camouflage in their luxe tree homes. They can drum 20 times per second with most pecking between 8,000-12,000 times per day. Drumming is also used to communicate along with feeding and home building.

Have you ever wondered how woodpeckers avoid skull-splitting headaches from all that pounding? It's because of an extra thick skull and chisellike beak. Both are cushioned by strong muscles that act as shock absorbers. Woodpeckers also use their feet and tails for better stability when perched on trees. Their specialized zygodactyl feet have two toes pointing forward and two pointing backward to grip vertical spaces. Their stiff tails will also act like a third leg.

Woodpeckers also have what's known as a third eyelid. This nictitating membrane is translucent and closes just before a woodpecker hits wood with its beak. It cleanses the eye as it moves over it.

Woodpecker nostrils have bristles in them to protect from wood chips and sawdust. The Downey woodpecker, our smallest, has the largest bristles. The long tongues of woodpeckers help to sweep out insects from inside trees and logs. The Red-bellied woodpecker's tongue can reach two inches past its beak. When retracted, their tongues will wrap around their skulls.

Woodpeckers are important members of the forest community. They consume lots of wood-boring insects. Besides insects, woodpeckers eat nuts, fruit, and seeds. Their abandoned tree cavities are prime real estate for bluebirds, chickadees, owls, squirrels and other wildlife unable to dig out their own homes.
