Bluebird Trail Report

Our Bluebirds now have 95 active nests containing 218 eggs and 154 chicks. Twelve more chicks have fledged.

We have one more competitor for our Bluebird nest boxes and they are the wrens, especially the House wrens. They are very cheeky little native birds that will attack an established Bluebird nest and if there are more than one nest box in an area, the male will claim all of the boxes by filling them with small twigs. Then he lets his female choose which box she likes best. She will then build a deep cup shaped nest with plant material and feathers. She lays six to eight tiny white eggs speckled with brown spots. The best way to stop wrens is to move the nest box away from woody, brushy areas to a more grassy, open area - at least 100 feet away from the woods.

In this week's photo, if you look carefully, you will see horizontal strips of wood have been installed across the North end of the barn's roof rafters. These components of the barn's roof are called purlins. Their main purpose is to provide a place to anchor the metal roofing panels. They also provide the entire roof structure additional stability. The final eight to nine sets of roof rafters will likely be constructed "on the ground," and then lifted into place with the use of a rented crane. Additional purlins will then be placed, and the final step will be the installation of the metal roofing panels. A huge thank you is in order for all of the volunteers who have been showing up every Wednesday and Thursday to help rebuild our 1870's barn.

Transforming a Piece of History with Innsbrook Custom Homes & Construction

Nestled within the dense Missouri hardwoods of Innsbrook Resort lies Chalet 229, an a-frame with a story constructed through the years. 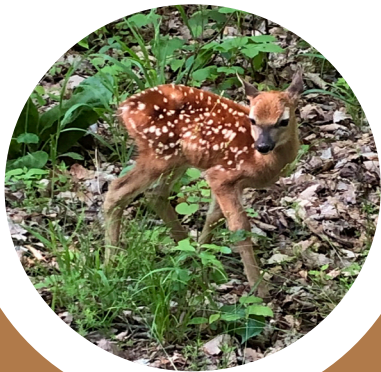

"All of the new spaces are great for entertaining, but many of the spaces are perfect for a quiet, solo day at Innsbrook," explained the homeowner. "Essentially, the finished chalet feels like a well-curated home, snuck into an a-frame. The result is pretty awesome."

In the realm of home remodels, it's not just about transforming spaces; it's about breathing new life into a house steeped with tradition, and embracing the beauty of reinvention. In the heart of Innsbrook's first development of a-frames, chalet 229 serves as an inspiring example of what can be achieved when creativity meets craftsmanship.

NATURE NOTES

Fawning Over Deer Fawns

It's that time of year where some of the cutest nature sightings are seen all around our beautiful community.

The delicate features of a deer fawn always seem to bring an "ooh" from even the gruffest of folks. A fawn's endearing look of helplessness has caused many to be taken from the wild.

Most people associate the deer fawns they see with "Bambi," Walt Disney's adorable orphan. And, the life of a real deer fawn is just as memorable as Hollywood's version. White-tailed deer fawns are born in late May or early June. Usually a doe, or female deer, has twins. Occasionally, a single fawn or triplets are born. Fawns arrive with their eyes open and within hours are able to stand on wobbly legs.

Fawns wear a rusty coat with scattered white spots until they're three to five months old. This pattern looks much like small patches of sunlight on the forest floor, helping to conceal the fawn from predators.

Most folks think young deer that are alone have been abandoned, but fawns seldom become orphaned in the wild. Deer have glands between their hooves that leave a scent as they walk. A doe is able to track down her fawn by smell if it wanders away. A fawn also bleats to call their mother. And, she's always within *hearing distance*. If you find a fawn lying alone in the wild, don't try to rescue it. Just remember that its mother knows where it is
