Innsbrook Bluebird Report

Our Innsbrook bluebirds are getting active! They are starting to establish territories and claiming nest boxes. You can observe the males just sitting on the top of the boxes and singing. If you have a bluebird nest box on your property it's time to check your box - is it clean? Does it need repairs? Have the woodpeckers enlarged your entrance hole? Now is the time to remedy these things. They usually start building their nests in March.

Don't have a nest box? Would you like one? The Innsbrook Bluebird Society has some beautiful new cedar boxes hand made by our master carpenter, Larry Tilly. The cost of the nest box is a \$60 donation and all monies collected go to support our bluebird trail. This includes the box, the mounting poles and hardware, the rebar for installation, and mounting on your Innsbrook property. If you'd like a baffle on your pole, this helps keep snakes out of the nest, they are \$15 extra.

Innsbrook Fishing Club - Stockpiled Bass at Innsbrook!

According to the Missouri Department of Conservation, all our lakes at Innsbrook (IBK) currently have an overabundance of slow-growing bass, typically in the 8" to 10" range. While these fish may appear to be young, they are actually older and have very little potential to grow any further. A high density of small bass like this disrupts the natural balance of species in our lakes and reduces overall fish health and quality.

To help address this issue, the Innsbrook Fishing Club has introduced tiger muskies into a few lakes as a natural way to help control the bass population. In addition, the Fishing Club strongly encourages all anglers at IBK to remove these small bass from the lakes when you catch them. These bass are completely safe to eat.

When possible, the Innsbrook Fishing Club also donates removed bass to help feed raptors and other birds at the World Bird Sanctuary. We are currently working to make a freezer available to all fishermen so that harvested bass can be placed in the freezer and later donated to the Sanctuary.

Your help is important. By removing these stockpiled bass, you are directly contributing to healthier lakes, better fishing, and a stronger ecosystem at IBK. Please help us remove these guys from our lakes.

Let's Keep the Water Flowing!

With the rainy season just around the corner, this is a friendly reminder about a small but important maintenance task: keeping the culvert (drainage pipe) under your driveway clear.

Why it matters: Culverts help storm-water flow safely away from our roads, driveways, and homes. When they become blocked with leaves, twigs, dirt, or other debris, water can back up and cause:

- Flooding on roads and driveways
- Erosion around your property
- Standing water (hello, mosquitoes!)
- Damage to the culvert itself

In our beautiful, wooded community, blocked culverts are one of the most common causes of localized flooding after heavy rains. Taking a few minutes to keep them clear helps protect your home — and your neighbors' too — and can prevent costly repairs down the road.

Whose responsibility is it? Culverts under private driveways are the homeowner's responsibility to maintain (similar to gutters or landscaping). This is standard in most communities, including Innsbrook.

How to clean your culvert:

1. **Inspect:** Use a flashlight to check both ends of the pipe for blockages. It's especially helpful to check after storms or if you notice pooling water.
2. **Clear debris:** Wear gloves and use a rake, shovel, or long pole to remove leaves, dirt, and sticks from both the inlet and outlet. Try not to push debris farther into the pipe.
3. **Flush:** Use a garden hose (or a pressure washer on low) from the higher end to wash out any remaining material. Be sure to direct water away from roads and neighboring properties.
4. **Check regularly:** Inspect quarterly, before major rain events, and especially during the fall when leaves are heavy.

NATURE NOTES

Tornado Season: Are You Ready?

In the Midwest states, peak tornado occurrence is in mid-March through late June. Missouri is considered at high risk from tornadoes and is in "tornado alley," which place the state in the top five for tornado activity. Check out the below information on how to stay safe during major storms in your area.

Know what to listen for:

- A "Tornado Watch" is issued when tornadoes are possible in your area. Remain alert for approaching storms.
- A "Tornado Warning" is issued when a tornado has been sighted or indicated by weather radar. Move to your pre-designated place of safety.

Stay informed of weather conditions by tuning into local radio and television stations, and take all watches and warnings seriously. Remember, tornadoes develop in areas where a severe thunderstorm watch or warning is in effect, so listen for that information as well. Remain alert!

Know what you can do - tornado safety: **Before the storm**

- Develop a plan for you and your family for home, work, school, and when outdoors.
- Hold frequent drills.
- Purchase an NOAA weather radio for your home.
- Know the county in which you live, and keep a highway map nearby to follow storm movement from weather bulletins.
- Listen to radio and television for information.

During the storm

- In a home or building, move to a pre-designated shelter, such as a basement.
- If an underground shelter is not available, move to an interior room or hallway on the lowest floor, and get under a sturdy piece of furniture.
- Stay away from windows.
- Get out of automobiles.
- Do not try to outrun a tornado in your car; instead, leave it immediately. If caught outside or in a vehicle, lie flat in a nearby ditch or depression.
