Innsbrook Bluebird Report

Our bluebirds have been hard at work, they have made 93 nests containing 323 eggs and 42 chicks have hatched this week! Now the female does all the actual nest building. And a nest can be completed in as little as two days, but often it takes four to five days if it is a young female. The nest is constructed of dried grasses, pine needles, fine weed stalks and occasionally fine plant rootlets. To form the hollow in the nest she will sit inside the nest and press her chest against the sides. This process is called molding. Once the nest is completed, she will start the egg laying within a day or two. Eggs are usually laid in the mornings between 7-9:30 a.m.

One egg is laid each day until the clutch is complete. Usually four to six eggs are in the clutch. If there are more than six eggs, egg dumping has occurred. That's when a different female intrudes and lays her egg in the resident female's nest. The resident female doesn't seem to be able to count and she incubates and raises the intruder's young as her own.

Innsbrook Fishing Club: Fish Freezer Now Available at the Library!

The IBK Fishing Club, thanks to your donations, has now added a box freezer available at the Library (O'Fishal Scale) for anglers to place harvested bass under 13" for the World Bird Sanctuary.

All our lakes at Innsbrook (IBK) currently have an overabundance of slow-growing bass, typically in the 8" to 10" range. While these fish may appear to be young, they are actually older and have very little potential to grow any further. A high density of small bass like this disrupts the natural balance of species in our lakes and reduces overall fish health and quality.

To help address this issue, the Fishing Club strongly encourages all anglers at IBK to remove small bass under 13" from the lakes when you catch them. These bass are completely safe to eat, placed in ziplocs and into the freezer for the World Bird Sanctuary, or dispose of them.

Your help is important. By removing these stockpiled bass, you are directly contributing to healthier lakes, better fishing, and a stronger ecosystem at IBK. Please help us remove these guys from our lakes.

Earth Day

Earth Day is an annual event celebrated on April 22 that raises awareness about protecting the planet and preserving natural resources for future generations. It began in 1970, inspired by growing environmental activism in the 1960s and led by U.S. Senator Gaylord Nelson and organizer Denis Hayes. The first Earth Day drew 20 million participants across the United States and helped build support for major environmental laws like the Clean Air Act and the Endangered Species Act.

Over time, Earth Day expanded into a global movement. By 1990, it had grown to include more than 200 million people in over 140 countries, and today it engages more than one billion participants worldwide. The Earth Day Network (EDN) now leads efforts year-round, partnering with thousands of organizations across nearly every country. Its mission emphasizes that everyone has a right to a healthy, sustainable environment and promotes action through education, public policy, and community involvement.

Earth Day focuses on a wide range of environmental issues, including climate change, conservation, renewable energy, sustainable agriculture, recycling, and green jobs. Through advocacy campaigns and local initiatives, individuals and communities are encouraged to take action—whether by reducing waste, supporting clean energy, or protecting biodiversity. What started as a single-day event has grown into a powerful global movement dedicated to creating a more sustainable future.

Trash Compactor

A trash compactor for household trash only is located at the trash depot just south of the Main Gate on Aspen Way Dr. To use the compactor, open the side door, place your trash in, and close the door. The compactor turns on automatically when trash reaches a certain point. DO NOT open the door when the green light is flashing and the siren is sounding. This indicates that the compactor is in operation. NEVER go inside the dumpster.

Prohibited Items

The following items are PROHIBITED in all Innsbrook dumpsters:

- Iron or steel
- Car parts or tires
- Construction debris, such as lumber, drywall, fixtures, etc.
- Appliances or bulky trash items such as furniture, mattresses, etc.
- Oil, paint or chemicals requiring special disposal
- Car batteries
