### Innsbrook Bluebird Report

Our Innsbrook bluebirds are loving our early warm spring! They have already made 66 nests and have laid 69 eggs. If you have a bluebird nest box on your property, now is the time to start monitoring it. You should try to check your box once a week or as often as you are out here. It's best to monitor during the middle of the day. Just open the box and do a quick peak at what's happening. If mom is in the box she might just stare at you or she might quickly fly off. Don't worry if she flies off, she will be back very soon. They will not abandon the nest because you disturbed them.

The nest is usually tall and made from neatly woven dried grass, with a cup like depression in the middle. The eggs (4-6) are usually powder blue but may be plain white. Please send your reports to [saritsema@gmail.com](mailto:saritsema@gmail.com) to be included in our weekly tally.

A report should contain four things:

1. Total number of nests in your boxes.
2. Total number of eggs in your nests.
3. Total number of chicks in your nests.

4. Total number of chicks that have fledged that week (if chicks have fledged, you do not count that nest in your nest count). Once chicks have fledged, pull out the old nest and throw it in the garbage.

## Don't Be "Trashy"

Innsbrook offers trash/recycling depots for property owners use:

- Just south of the Main Gate on Aspen Way Dr.
- Just north of the Farmhouse off Innsbrook Dr.
- At the Konstanz Gate Entrance off South Konstanz Dr.
- At the Linden Gate Entrance off Linden Crossing
- At the Tyrol Gate

DO NOT use the trash or recycle bins at the Clubhouse Bar & Grille, Charrette Creek Commons, or at the Aspen Center; these are for commercial use only.

### Trash Compactor

A trash compactor for household trash only is located at the trash depot just south of the Main Gate on Aspen Way Dr. To use the compactor, open the side door, place your trash in, and close the door. The compactor turns on automatically when trash reaches a certain point. DO NOT open the door when the green light is flashing and the siren is sounding. This indicates that the compactor is in operation. NEVER go inside the dumpster.

### Prohibited Items

The following items are PROHIBITED in all Innsbrook dumpsters:

- Iron or steel
- Car parts or tires
- Construction debris, such as lumber, drywall, fixtures, etc.
- Appliances or bulky trash items such as furniture, mattresses, etc.
- Oil, paint or chemicals requiring special disposal
- Car batteries

### Spring Big Trash Weekend!

For two days only, April 11-April 12 from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., dumpsters will be available for disposal of your bulky, unwanted items and trash -- including furniture at the Property Management Building. No construction or auto waste will be accepted, so no toilets, bathtubs, broken tiles, and no auto parts or tires! Only bring items from your Innsbrook property, absolutely no outside waste, please.

### Security at Trash Sites

To maintain cleanliness and efficiency, we'll be imposing a \$250 fee for improper use of our dumpsters or compactors. Our enhanced surveillance allows us to monitor activities closely, ensuring that only appropriate items are disposed of.
