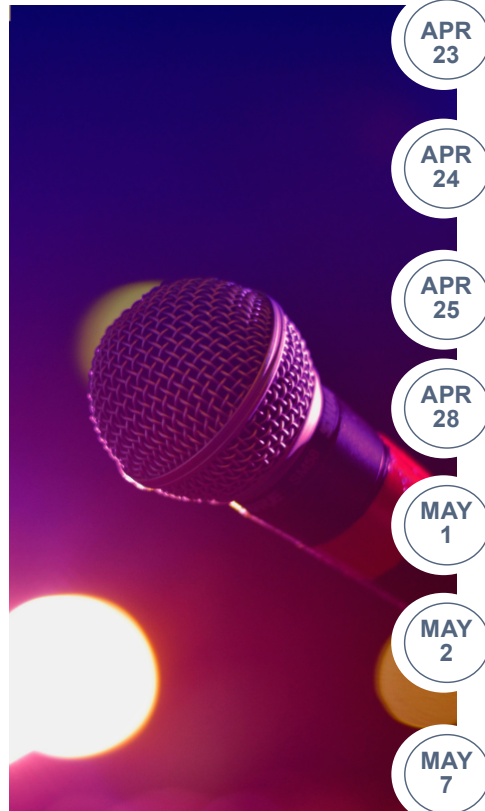

Innsbrook Bluebird Report

The Innsbrook bluebirds now have made 99 nests! These nests contain 187 eggs and 202 hungry chicks.

When does the bluebird mom start to incubate the eggs she has laid over four to five days? She does not start incubation until the day after the last egg is laid. Once she starts incubation the eggs are kept warm all the time. They must be warmed to at least 95 degrees F. The female's body temperature is at 106 degrees. If the eggs were to get warmer than 107 degrees, they will die. The female develops a brood patch. This is an area on the breast where the down feathers are shed and an increased number of blood vessels develop. By the time the chicks fledge, her skin has returned to normal and if a second or third brood occurs, the development of blood vessels starts all over again. Only the female incubates the eggs, she gently turns the eggs several times a day to keep them evenly warm and this helps to keep the inner membranes of the egg from sticking to the shell. Average incubation is 12-14 days. Meanwhile, the male tries to protect the nest from other birds and frequently brings food to the nesting female.

Innsbrook Fishing Club News

The IBK Fishing Club has been actively improving local lakes this spring by building and installing fish habitats in several larger bodies of water. These structures provide critical breeding and shelter areas for fish, supporting healthier populations and enhancing overall lake ecology. Signs posted near the lakes indicate where these habitats are located, but they do not interfere with boating or swimming. Previous fish population testing also revealed an overabundance of smaller, stunted bass in the 8"-10" range. To help rebalance the ecosystem, members are encouraged to remove any bass under 13" when caught.

To further support wildlife, the club has partnered with the World Bird Sanctuary. A new freezer located at the IBK Library allows

members to donate smaller bass, which will be used to feed birds in need. Members are asked to bag any bass under 13" and place them in the freezer (located on the side of the library near the O'Fisnal scale). The club also encourages participation in upcoming projects and events, including habitat installation and fish donation drives, to strengthen the community and benefit local wildlife. NATURE NOTES

Understanding Copperheads

If copperheads are a fear factor for you, there is hope and help. Since they don't look like other Missouri snakes, they are easy to identify and avoid.

Missouri's copperheads are pinkish tan with dark-brown markings along their backs that are shaped like an hourglass or bow tie. This camouflage look helps them hide from prey in leaves along rocky hillsides and forest edges. They make excellent exterminators as their diet is mostly mice and voles.

Copperheads are active from April through November, and have young from August through early October. They are not aggressive and seldom strike unless provoked.

Discourage copperheads from around your home by getting rid of wood or rock piles and tall grass. Wear boots when in woods or brushy fields, and leather gloves when moving rocks, old lumber and firewood.

Copperhead Facts

- Copperheads hunt for a variety of small animals, but mice make up most of their prey, so copperheads play an important role in limiting their populations.
- Copperheads eat mice, lizards, frogs, small birds, insects (especially cicadas), and sometimes small snakes.
- Young copperheads use their yellow tail as a lure to attract small frogs or lizards.
- However, they often rely on their camouflage pattern when resting in dead leaves and will usually remain motionless when encountered.

Trash Compactor

A trash compactor for household trash only is located at the trash depot just south of the Main Gate on Aspen Way Dr. To use the compactor, open the side door, place your trash in, and close the door. The compactor turns on automatically when trash reaches a certain point. DO NOT open the door when the green light is flashing and the siren is sounding. This indicates that the compactor is in operation. NEVER go inside the dumpster.

Prohibited Items
