Property Management Update: Lakes

The property management team continues to make steady progress on several important lake projects. St. Gallen Lake has been placed on the DNR's high-priority list. Engineering work is complete, and the permit is expected to be finalized soon, which should allow our crew to begin the project in the near future. At this time, the lake is being lowered gradually at a rate of six inches per day. The goal is to reach approximately five feet below full pool, although current weather conditions may impact how close we can get to that target.

The Wren Lake spill tube repair is scheduled for Friday, May 1.

Work on Marina 2 is underway, with the contractor expected to be onsite two to three days per week until the project is complete.

In addition, we will soon begin seasonal lake treatments, including spraying for weeds and applying granular algae control. Water quality testing will also be conducted to ensure the lakes are safe for swimming.

Friendly Innsbrook Reminders

As Innsbrook enters its busy season, we kindly remind all property owners to help maintain a safe, smooth, and enjoyable environment for everyone. All guests and contractors must have a valid guest authorization entered through the owner's portal (<https://ibkapps.innsbrook-resort.com/ibk-resident/>) prior to arrival. If you need assistance entering authorizations, security is happy to help by calling ext. 9403. Once authorized, all guests and contractors must enter through a manned gate (Main Gate or West Gate) to receive a pass, after which they may use unmanned gates for the duration of that pass. Please note that all guests must be registered at the Main Gate, and pin code access is reserved for physical pass holders only.

Recreational vehicles such as ATVs, UTVs, and boats must be registered—unregistered vehicles are not permitted on property.

Pets must be leashed at all times and are not allowed on beaches, where posted rules must be followed.

As a proud "Dark Sky" community, all exterior lighting should be turned off before retiring for the evening to reduce light pollution.

For the safety and comfort of all, fireworks, weapons, and drones are strictly prohibited.

Innsbrook Bluebird Report

Our Bluebirds are off to a really good start. We have 98 nests containing 69 eggs and 320 chicks!

That's the best start in a long time. We've recently been asked why we have that piece of white pvc pipe around some of our bluebird poles? It's our homemade snake baffle, made out of pvc piping and caps. Why we do it is because of predators, especially black rat snakes. These snakes are the most successful predators of our bluebirds. Our poles are usually very high at six to seven feet to discourage snakes but every once in a while a snake climbs the pole. They will eat the eggs, chicks, and even an adult if it can catch it. They are not aggressive snakes to humans as long as you do not threaten or try to pick it up. They have very small but sharp teeth. They readily climb trees and wooden poles to check out nests or tree hollows for nests. Out of precaution, please never mount a birdhouse on a tree trunk or plain wooden pole.

Severe Weather Information

As spring settles into Innsbrook, it brings longer days, warmer weather, and more time to enjoy the outdoors—but it also marks the start of severe weather season. Preparing in advance is key to keeping yourself and your family safe.

Start by identifying reliable ways to receive emergency alerts, such as a weather radio, wireless alerts on your phone, or updates from the Warren County Emergency Management Agency. You can sign up for updates by visiting <https://warrencountyma.com/>.

It's also important to follow trusted weather sources and have a clear shelter plan before storms develop. Per the state of Missouri, FEMA, and the NSSA, buildings designated as storm shelters are required to meet a very specific criteria to withstand wind and debris. We must advise residents and guests to act in the best interest of safety and proceed to areas designated as such in the event they do not have a basement or sufficient shelter, and follow any instruction given by the Warren County Emergency Management Agency.

Please remember, Charrette Creek Commons is not a designated shelter and should not be used during severe weather.

When storms approach, act quickly. For severe thunderstorms with high winds or large hail, move to the lowest, most interior part of a sturdy structure. In the event of a tornado warning, take immediate shelter in the lowest level available, staying away from windows, doors, and exterior walls.

Being proactive and informed can make all the difference—so stay alert, take warnings seriously, and don't wait until the last minute to get to safety.

Trash Compactor

A trash compactor for household trash only is located at the trash depot just south of the Main Gate on Aspen Way Dr. To use the compactor, open the side door, place your trash in, and close the door. The compactor turns on automatically when trash reaches a certain point. DO NOT open the door when the green light is flashing and the siren is sounding. This indicates that the compactor is in operation. NEVER go inside the dumpster.

Prohibited Items

- Car parts or tires
- Construction debris, such as lumber, drywall, fixtures, etc.
- Appliances or bulky trash items such as furniture, mattresses, etc.
